2011: a Year in Review

A Life Honored: Regina S. McCormick Memorial Scholarship Created

Each spring brings scholarship applications to the Foundation... a busy time for the staff and Scholarship Selection Committee. This time is always bittersweet for us: difficult that we are unable to fund each application that comes in, yet exciting and rewarding to fund the ones we can, knowing that we've made a positive impact on the youth in our communities.

This spring brought great sadness as we helped mourn the sudden loss of one of our county's finest teachers, Regina S. McCormick. There was an immediate urging by her family and friends to continue Regina's dedication to the education of Boone County students and the Foundation was launched into the amazing process of assisting in the creation of a scholarship fund in her honor. For several months afterward, individual and group donations flowed into the Foundation for the purpose of building the fund, and we are happy to announce that it currently stands at \$9,644.50... a mere \$355.50 from the minimum amount required to establish a named fund. The outpouring of support was truly humbling and we felt it a privilege to facilitate a charitable vessel through which Regina's lifelong commitment to children can remain forever constant through scholarship awards.

The Regina S. McCormick Memorial Scholarship will incubate for a minimum of one year after reaching the minimum \$10,000. Upon completion of this mandatory waiting time, graduating seniors from Scott High School entering an in-state college or university in an education major will be eligible to apply.

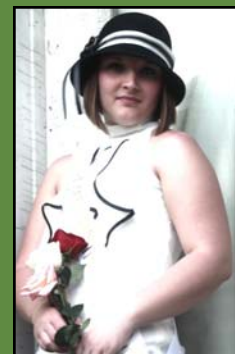

2011 Grant Recipients

Boone County Schools Autism Program: To create a lending library of resources and materials to be made available for parent and community support of children and families impacted by autism.

Boone Madison Public Library: To purchase genealogy and legal forms programs and software for public use.

Boone Memorial Hospital: To purchase an infrared device that will aid in locating veins for patients who experience difficulty with vein access.

Gabriel Project of WV: To provide car seats, cribs, and other baby necessities to families in Boone County who are in need.

REV UP Madison: To provide a downtown mini-park for the purpose of beautification and recreation in the downtown Madison area.

TEAM for WV Children: To provide trained volunteers who help represent the rights of Boone County children who are involved in the court system due to abuse or neglect.

Good Intentions... Great Rewards Donor-Advised Fund Distributions

The beauty of Donor-Advised funds is the ability to share in the grantmaking process. As a family, you can build a tradition of giving to your community through a family named fund. How does it work? Your family makes a gift to the Community Foundation and receives tax benefits in the year the gift is made. We set up an endowment that is invested over time. As interest income grows, you and your family can make recommendations to the Foundation for the organizations you want to receive grants. We handle all the administrative details and issue the grants in your family fund's name. Sometimes it takes time to build those grants, but you can take heart in knowing that your family fund will become a permanent source of community charity, helping to meet the needs and do good work for many lifetimes.

One of the Foundation's Donor-Advised funds, the **Thomas T. and Mary Frances Ellis Fund**, awarded the 2011 grant to REV UP Madison. REV UP Madison is an extension group of the City of Madison, whose goal is to increase beauty and positive activity in the downtown Madison area. REV UP has been building a mini-park in honor of Thomas T. and Mary Frances Ellis and this grant will be directed toward its completion.

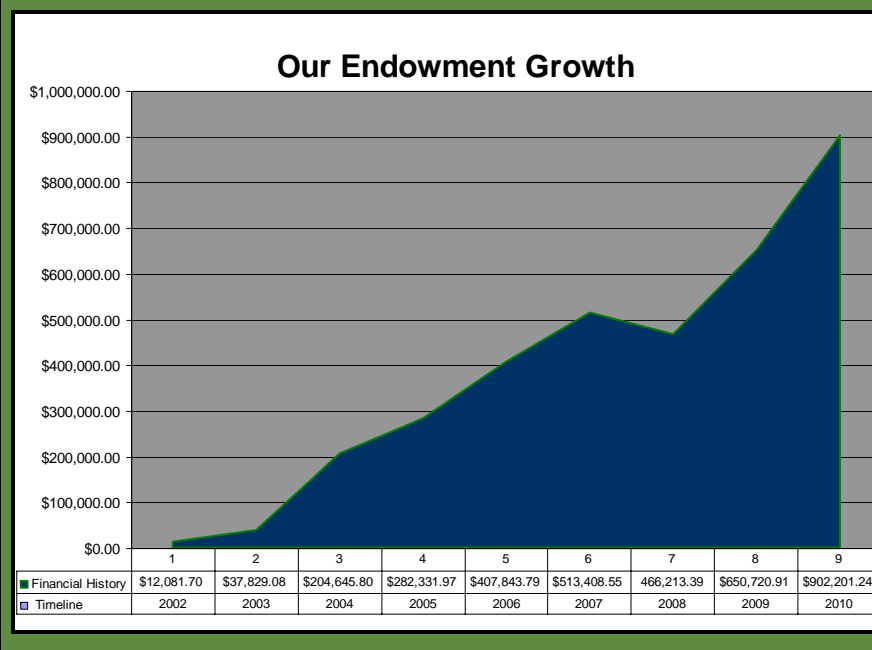
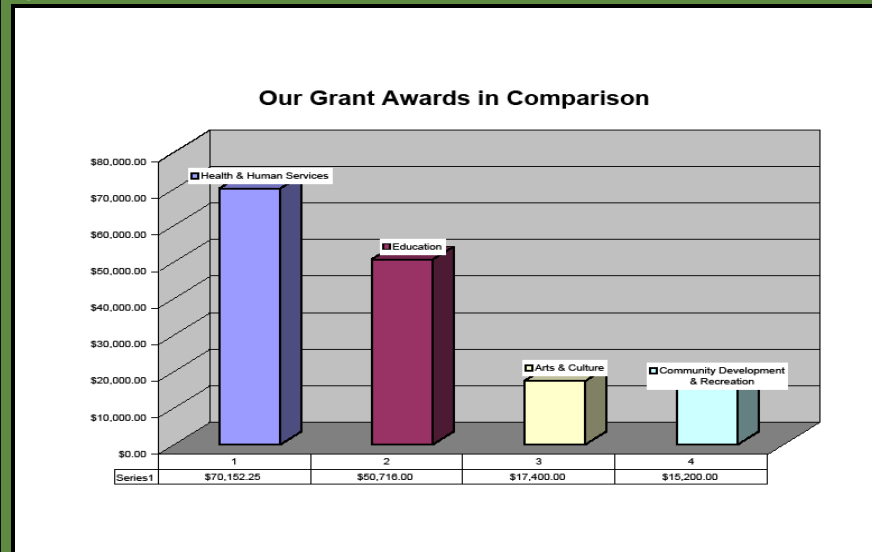
